TERM OF COMPETITION

4Th MENPORA – PAGI Junior International Golf Championship 2024 will be played at **Emeralda Golf Club, Jalan Cimanggis Boulevard, Tapos – Depok 16953 INDONESIA** in accordance with the Golf Rules imposed by the latest R & A Rules & USGA, PGI (Indonesia Golf Association) 2024 Hardcard, Competition Provisions, Attachments and Additional Local Rules made by the Committee whose decision in all matters relating to the championship shall be final and binding.

The MENPORA (Ministry of Sport and Youth of the Republic of Indonesia) CUP 2024 will be awarded to the Best Gross Champions of Boy and Girl of Divisions A and B after three rounds of competition.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRIES

The Championship is open to all junior golfers who are **under 19 years** old on Nov 1st, 2024 and similarly for their age groups. All players must be an amateur in accordance with the rules of amateur stat us as approved by the R&A Rules Limited.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. Eligibility

The championship will be decided by stroke play over 3 (three) rounds of 18 holes for Divisions A and B (Boys and Girls) and 2 (two) rounds for Divisions C and D (Boys and Girls); and be conducted over the following age groups:

Note:

- The Overall Boy and Girl Champions shall be the player with the lowest gross aggregate score over the three rounds.
- Players will also compete in the respective age groups
- The Champions are not eligible for the Age Group Best Gross Winners
- Registration Closed, September 30th, 2024

2. Team Event

Every country may propose up to 3 (three) its best Players, any combination of Divisions A and/or B Players, to compete in a team event over three rounds of the Championship. The total of two lowest scores will count as the team's score of each three rounds. Every country may submit 1 team of boy and 1 team of girl. Indonesia may submit up to 2 teams of boy's ad 2 teams of girl.

All team members must be registered not later than October 28, 2024 during the technical meeting

SIZE OF FIELD

- The total field will be limited to a maximum of 84 Players, a combination of both Indonesian and International Golfers, and is based on first come first serve basis.
- However, The Organizing Committee has discretion of full right to decide the final number of Players in this Championship.

RULES OF GOLF

- The Championship will be played in accordance with the rules of golf as approved by the R&A Rules limited and Additional Condition of Competition and Local Rules approved by the Organizing Committee.
- Disputes, if any, will be settled by the Committee, and a decision made by the Committee will be final.
- If a Tournament Rules Official or Referee is not immediately available, a player who is uncertain about the right procedures while playing a hole may complete the hole with two balls without penalty (see Rule 20.1c(3).

CADDIES

 All players are only allowed to use the "in house" caddies and no parents or official are allowed to caddy the players.

TRANSPORTATION

Players A & B (Boys & Girls) are not allowed to use buggy or during stipulated around. Players C and D allowed to use any motorized vehicles during the Championship.

PACE OF PLAY

All Players shall play only in accordance with the Pace of play guidelines.











BREACH OF CONDUCT

All players should play and comply with detailed Rules of Section 1.2 of the Rules of Golf. The overriding principle is that consideration should be shown to others on the course at all time. The following may be considered "serious breaches of conduct" for this competition:

- 1. The use of mobile phones and any other similar noise making devices during play to the annoyance and distractions of other players. However, repetitive usage of a mobile phone without consideration to other players, or
- 2. Intentionally distracting or offending fellow competitors, or
- 3. Verbal abuse of fellow competitors / officials / staff, will be considered serious breach of conduct.

Note: Any other "breach of conduct" not listed above will be dealt with by the Committee case by case

PENALTY FOR SERIOUS BREACH OF CONDUCT: DISQUALIFICATION

SPECTATORS/ ACCOMPANYING OFFICIALS/PARENTS

- Spectators/accompanying official/parents must remain on the cart paths at all times. They must stay off the greens and out of the bunkers at all times.
- They should maintain a reasonable distance from the players to avoid the appearance that they are imparting advice or assisting the player in any way. They may approach a player for a moment to exchange clothing, food or beverage, but should not have prolonged contact.
- Those found violating these policies may be asked to leave the course

TROPHIES

1. Individual Competition

Trophies will be awarded to:

- The MENPORA (Ministry of Sport and Youth of the Republic of Indonesia) CUP 2024 will be awarded to the Best Gross Champions of Boy and Girl of Divisions A and B after three rounds of competition.
- Boys (Divisions of A, B, C, and D)

: 3 best scores, Champion to 2nd runner-up

Girls (Divisions of A, B, C, and D)

: 3 best scores, Champion to 2rd runner-up

2. Team Competition

Trophies will be awarded to:

- Champion Team (Boys & Girls)
- 1st Runner-up (Boys & Girls)











DRESS CODE

- All Players must be properly attired during Championship. Blue jeans, designer jeans, round neck T-shirt and tank tops are prohibited.
- A player violating this dress code will not be permitted to play during the Championship.

TIMELINE

• October 28, 2024 : Official Practice Round, Registration Tournament,

Technical Meeting around Lunch Opening 3:00 pm,

October 29, 2024 : 1st day tournament for Divisions A, B, C and D (Boys and Girls)

• October 30, 2024 : 2nd day tournament for Divisions A and B (Boys and Girls), and final day of

tournament for Divisions C and D (Boys and Girls)

• October 31, 2024 : Final tournament day for Divisions of A and B (Boys and Girls) & Closing

OFFICIAL PRACTICE

Official practice round on October 28, 2024. Tee-time will be determined by Club's Starter.

Players will have to pay Official Practice Round IDR 598.000 (Caddy fee & Cart)

• Players are not allowed to play multiple balls during the practice round and practice on the course after their round on any day of the Championship.

PAIRING & TEE-OFF TIME

- Tee times and pairings will be posted on the announcement board at the Club House, website and will be distributed to All Players at Golf Course
- All Players have to be ready at least 15 minutes at their own tee-box prior to tee-off time and to start playing as stated on the tee-off time.

DISTANCE-MEASURING DEVICE

Players may use a Range Finder Equipment without any **Slope-Feature**. Any breach of this regulation will be disqualified.

RETURNING THE SCORE CARD

Players' score cards have to be submitted by Players to Scoring Officers and once Players leave the scoring room, they could not request the submitted score cards for any reasons.











TIES

In the event of ties, the Committee will decide as follow:

- 1. The Champion will be settled hole by hole play off
- 2. The other winner ties will be decided by count back system,

The last 18 holes of final round scores,

- Last 9 holes, if a tie still persists, then,
- Last 6 holes, if a tie still persists, then,
- Last 3 holes, if a tie still persists, then,
- Hole 18.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

The Committee will make every effort to complete this tournament entirely. However, The Committee reserves the right to suspend or abandon play as necessary if weather-related circumstances require such action. In the event the course is unplayable and abandons play or other conditions warranting such action, the Committee then will decide on the action taken for The Championship and all Players will be informed accordingly.

EVACUATION PLAN

The Committee has full discretion, for emergency purposes, take players and caddies to shelter on the course and/or to the Clubhouse.

All players and their caddies will be transported back to their last location on the course, while waiting for the signal to resume play.

MARKER

- A Marker is an individual appointed by tournament committee to write-down or make a record of score of Players
- The Marker can be a Player (s) who will write down score of another Player. Caddy cannot be Marker for any reasons.

TOURNAMENT CLOSING

The tournament is considered finished once officially closed and Champion names are disclosed on the information board.
